Staff promptly evaluate clients in order to determine type of treatment required and arrange for the provision of such treatment in least restrictive setting as close to home as possible. The expectation is that the provision of services and relevant supports will result in resolution of the crisis.</p> <p>The PES/Screening Center offers immediate crisis intervention services, which are culturally competent, as well as service procurement to de-escalate client's distress and to help maintain or recover his/her level of functioning. Emphasis is on stabilization so the client can actively participate in the treatment plan.</p> <p>Treatment may take place in the form of face-to-face evaluation in hospital emergency rooms or in the community via mobile outreach, polycom video conferencing, or by telephone. All services are available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. AWARE provides group therapy, family therapy, psychiatric evaluations, medication monitoring, and creative arts therapies to adolescents diagnosed with range of psychiatric disorders. Groups include Coping, Anger Management, Social Skills, Communication, Maintenance, Symptom Recognition, and Goal Review, among others. Program is after-school (4:00 P.M. to 8:00), dinner provided. Transportation provided to youth throughout Passaic County through Logisticare.
